STEP II - Reason for Appeal With the processing of incoming U.S.P.S. mail admittedly running as much as a month behind in violation of PD 05.03.118 (FEI), grievant has no way of knowing or ascertaining if his parcels, such as said workers included, are being delivered late or not delivered at all, i.e., lost or stolen, after arriving at URF mail room. Either way, whether delivered late or not at all, this constitutes the criminal deprivation of both grievant's and sender's 14th Civil Rights under color of law and criminal interference with U.S.P.S. mail in violation of 18 USC 852, 242, 1702, & 1703. Further, M. McLean's failure to know and follow law, rule and policy constitutes a willful neglect of duty, obstruction of justice, misprison and misconduct in office in violation of MCL 19.142, MCL 750.478 and MCL 750.505, as well as engaging in the furtherance of said conspiracy in violation of 18 USC 3521, 242, 1702 & 1703. Wherein remedy demanded at Step I must be granted and applied to McLean. N. Bond 4/14/18

STEP III - Reason for Appeal Step II Response only serves to implicate Warden Connie Horton in the policy, rule, law and civil rights violation. As maintained by grievant for well over a year there is a broad conspiracy to deprive grievant of his right, and sender's, to send and receive mail at URF, including the mail room's flagrant and repeated violations of mail policy, PD 05.03.118 and grievance coordinator M. McLean's repeated violation of PD 03.02.130. Wherein remedy demanded at steps I and II must be granted and this matter turned over to U.S.P.S. Postal Inspector, FBI and U.S. Atty. General for investigation and prosecution (as well as state authorities for state law violations).

URF mail room employees have, again, for the 4th and 5th time this year failed to deliver grievant's Workers World newspapers to him as required. PD 05.03.118; OP 05.03.118A; Admin. R. 791.6603; MCL 800.43. Thus, violating grievant's constitutional rights, and the senders, to freedom of speech and press, as well as to send and receive U.S. P.S. mail. U.S. Const. Am. I & III; and Mich Const. art. 1, §5. Moreover, said failure is a direct violation of federal law, as it is an act of interference with U.S.P.S. mail and act taken under color of law to deprive grievant and sender of their civil rights. 18 U.S.C. §§ 1702, 1703, 241 & 242. Said mail was to be processed and delivered to grievant "within one business day" or "within two business days" of its arrival at URF, depending on whether or not either issue arrived before or after 3/01/18. PD 05.03.118 (HHA) or (IIP). Wherefore, said newspapers must be immediately produced and handed over to grievant or, alternatively, this matter be turned over to U.S. P.S. Postal Inspector, R. B. T., or U.S. Attorney General for prosecution under federal law and Michigan State Police and Attorney General for prosecution under state law.
