


STEP II GRIEVANCE RESPONSE FOR PRISONER GOULD 187131 (ARF)

Sent letter to URF mail room demanding explanation why my request for hearing, in concern of R Valle's unlawful mail rejection of 3/20/18, signed by me on 3/20/18 and placed in B-Unit mail box on 3/22/18, was stamped "RECEIVED APR 8," with no response for the morning of this date

State problem clearly. Use separate grievance form for each issue. Additional pages, using plain paper, may be used. Four copies of each page and supporting documents must be submitted with this form. The grievance must be submitted to the Grievance Coordinator in accordance with the time limits of OP 03.02.130.

On 4/09/18, P.C. Ledford informed grievant he would be holding a hearing in concern of Notice of Package/Mail Rejection (NP/MR), "1 Magazine Violence/Criminal" from Prison Legal News, R. Valle GOA7, 3/20/18, and handed him a copy of the said NP/MR, as signed by grievant on 3/20/18, and stamped "RECEIVED APR 8" by URF mail room. Since grievant placed same in B-Unit mail box on 3/22/18, it would've been received in the mail room no later than Friday, 3/23/18 or, at worst, no later than Monday, 3/26/18. Therefore, the stamped date of 4/08/18 is fraudulent and, all the more so, because April 8th is a Sunday and the URF mail room does not operate on Sundays. It is more likely than not that mail room staff committed this fraud and illegal alteration of a document in an effort to deprive grievant of his right to a hearing and due process, along with his right to receive U.S.P.S. mail. That this deprivation of grievant's civil rights was done under color of law and involves more than one MDOC employee rises to the level of a conspiracy to do so and to interfere with U.S.P.S. mail in violation of 18 USC §§ 241, 242, 1702 & 1703. It is also rock-solid proof of staff corruption, failure to know and follow rules, policies and law in violation of MCL 19.142, as well as willful neglect of public duty, misconduct in office, obstruction of justice and misprison in violation of MCL 750.477 and MCL 750.505. This matter requires to be turned over to federal and state Attorney Generals for prosecution.
