STEP II - Reason for Appeal. A grievance shall not be rejected because grievance coordinator M. McLean cannot differentiate between a grievance on 12/07/17 violation of PD 05.03.118 (IHHH) and repeat violations of said policy on 12/12/17 and 12/15/17. The former from Wilks & Hems, the latter two items of mail from K. Gould and Michigan Lifers Assn. respectively. Entirely different letters from different people and organizations. Patently illogical. The author of this rejection should either be turned over to Internal Affairs for investigation of flagrant staff corruption or subject to psychiatric examination. At minimum, remedy demanded at Step I must be granted and M. McLean subject to employee discipline pursuant to PD 02.03.100.
