STEP II — Reason for Appeal *All Step I's non-response/rejection makes clear is that grievance coordinator M. McLean has no intention of complying with grievance policy and due process, any more than mail room staff have of complying with mail policy. As McLean well-knows, grievant has written numerous kites and grievances in concern of the illegal interference with, by delayed delivery of his U.S. P.S. incoming mail, in this case approximately 13 days after its arrival at URF mail room, a prior to filing the grievance, in accordance with PD 03.02.130 (6), PD 05.03.118 (III), formerly (PHH), requires delivery within "two business days," and Federal law makes it a crime to interfere with U.S. P.S. mail, 18 USC §§ 1702 R 1703, and a crime to deprive grievant of his civil rights under color of law, 18 USC §§ 241 R 242. Wherefore, remedy demanded at Step I must be granted and applied to McLean and persecutor, MPOW P. LaLonde.*

STEP III — Reason for Appeal *All the so-called grievance "process" serves to illustrate is the failure to know and conform to policy, rule and law by URF staff so involved, as well as their flagrant neglect of their public duties, obstruction of justice, misconduct in office and misprison, all of which are criminal law violations as set forth in MCL 14.142, MCL 750.478 and MCL 750.505. As such, they are all engaged in an active conspiracy to interfere with, if not steal U.S. P.S. mail, as well as to deprive grievant and sender of their civil rights under color of law in violation of 18 USC §§ 1702 R 1703 and 18 USC §§ 241 R 242. Wherefore, demands requested at steps I and II must be granted and all URF staff charged and prosecuted accordingly.*

 If none, explain why. Numerous attempts have been made by grievant to resolve what has been an ongoing problem since 11/01/17, with no resolution obtained

State problem clearly. Use separate grievance form for each issue. Additional pages, using plain paper, may be used. Four copies of each page and supporting documents must be submitted with this form. The grievance must be submitted to the Grievance Coordinator in accordance with the time limits of OP 03.02.130.

On 3/09/18, grievant received a letter from MAPS, dated 2/20/18, approximately 13 days after its arrival at URF mail room, allowing 4 days for delivery by U.S.P.S. This is a direct violation of PD 05.03.118 (4444), which requires mail to be processed "within one business day after receipt." This, also, constitutes interference with U.S.P.S. mail in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1702 & 1703.

Wherefore, grievant demands URF mail room staff cease violating policy and law, and be subject to employee discipline, PD 02.03.100, accordingly, with this matter turned over to Internal Affairs, Michigan State Police and Attorney General for violation of state law, MCL 19.142, MCL 750.478, and MCL 750.505, and U.S.P.S. Postal Inspector and U.S. Attorney General for ~~investigation~~ investigation and prosecution of federal law violations. 18 U.S.C. §§ 241, 242, 1702 & 1703.
