STEP II — Reason for Appeal All Step I's non-response/rejection makes clear is that grievance coordinator McMelean has no intention of complying with grievance policy and due process; any more than URF mailroom staff have of complying with mail policy, and that all parties concerned already in the process have every intention of continuing to engage in a conspiracy to interfere with U.S.P.S. mail and deprive grievant of his civil rights under the color of law in direct violation of 18 USC §§ 241, 242, 1702 & 1703. McMelean well knows grievant has written numerous letters and grievances "prison to" instant grievance regarding 18-day delay in delivering his U.S.P.S. mail after its arrival at URF in violation of P.D.O.S. 03.118 (IPP) formerly (HITF), which requires it be delivered "within two business days." See P.D.O.S. 130 (6), wherefore, remedy demanded at Step I must be granted and applied to McMelean and renewed, HOW D. Lalonde, R. Gould 3/27/18

STEP III — Reason for Appeal As indicated by Step II response, the staff corruption at URF spreads from the top of its administration like the cancer it is, with warden Horton fully engaged in the conspiracy to deprive grievant of his civil rights under color of law by denying him any due process in seeking a resolution through the grievance process of URF mail room staff's admitted violation of P.D.O.S. 03.118 (IPP) and interference with U.S.P.S. mail, 18 USC §§ 241, 242, 1702 & 1703. In doing so Horton has neglected to perform her public duty, obstructed justice, engaged in misconduct in office and misprison. MCL 750.473, and MCL 750.505. Remedy demanded at Step I and II must be granted and all concerned prosecuted according to law.


On 3/09/18, grievant received a letter from Willis X Harris of Michigan Lifers Assn., Inc, dated 2/15/18, approximately 18 days after its arrival at URF mail room, allowing for 4 days delivery ^{for U.S.P. 31}. This is a direct violation of PD 05.03.118 (U/H/H), which requires mail to be processed "within one business day after receipt." As such, this constitutes interference with U.S.P.S. mail in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1702 & 1703. ^{staff} Therefore grievant demands the URF mail room ^{staff} cease violating policy ^{and laws} and be subject to employee discipline pursuant to PD 02.03.100, with this matter ~~be~~ turned over to Internal Affairs, Michigan State Police and Attorney General for violation of state law. MCL 15.142; MCL 750.478; and MCL 750.525. Otherwise, it must be turned over to U.S.P.S. Postal Inspector and U.S. Attorney General for investigation and prosecution.
