STEP II - Reason for Appeal Clearly Unable to read and/or comprehend the English language, grievance coordinator M. McLean falsely claims instant grievance in concern of URF mail room staff's failure to deliver "Workers World, Vol. 60, No. 2, Jan. 11, 2018" is, ~~somehow~~ incredibly, a duplicate of "URF 1801029615E" (sic), which concerned the delivery of Workers World, Vol. 59, No. 51, Dec. 21, 2017 on 1/19/18, nearly six (6) ^{weeks} after its arrival in URF's mail room, in violation of PD 05.03.118 (HIII). Surely, it is necessary to point out the obvious: ~~two different newspapers, two different reasons for grievance~~ - Failure to deliver and delivery six (6) weeks late. Wherefore, grievant demands remedy requested at Step I be granted and M. McLean be subject to employee discipline pursuant to PD 02.03.100 for staff corruption and/or incompetence, failure to comply with Civil Service files, Ethical Standards and Conduct, willful neglect of duty, misprison and misconduct in office, in violation of MCL 19.142, MCL 750.478, and MCL 750.505, ~~and this matter be turned over to Internal Affairs for investigation.~~

McLean, is engaged in a deliberate act of obstruction of justice in order to cover up flagrant staff corruption and incompetence in URF's mail room. Wherefore, grievant's demands at Steps I & II must be granted, with this matter turned over to Michigan Attorney General for investigation and prosecution for the violations of MCL 19.142, MCL 750.478 and MCL 750.505. Further, this matter must be turned over to the U.S. Postal Inspector's Office and U.S. Attorney General's Office for investigation of the violations of 18 USC §§ 1702 & 1703, and 18 USC §§ 241 & 242, respectively.


STEP II GRIEVANCE RESPONSE FOR PRISONER GOULD 187131 B-176 (URF)

URF mail room employees received grievant's subscription copy of Workers World, Vol. 60, No. 2, Jan. 11, 2018 on or about said date, with normal delivery approximately one (1) week prior to date of newspaper. However, allowing for the several weeks time lag from mail room employees' receipt of mail until actual delivery to prisoners, grievant allowed approximately one (1) month to pass before Kiting mail room and writing this grievance. See URF 18 01 00192 28E, Step II Appeal, where Workers World, Vol. 59, No. 50, Dec. 14, 2017 was delivered to grievant on Jan. 19, 2018, well over a month after receipt by URF mail room employees and five (5) days after grievance was written. See also URF 17 12 03746 015E, Step I Response where respondent admits mail is being delivered late in violation of PD 05.03.118 (HWH).
Wherefore, as URF mail room employees have failed to deliver said newspaper to grievant in violation of both his and sender's rights to send and receive U.S. P.S. mail as set forth in U.S. Const. Am. I, Mich. Const. Art. I, § 5, 19 USC §§ 1702, 1703, MCL 800.43, Admin. R. 791.6603 and PD 05.03.118, grievant demands his newspaper be delivered on mail room employees' be subject discipline pursuant to PD 02.03.100 and this matter turned over to USPS postal inspectors. 2/06/18
