STEP II - Reason for Appeal Step I Respondent Mr. McLean's rejection of grievance clearly exhibiting yet another violation of OP 05.03.118A(C)(6)(a) is utterly baseless, thus constituting a compelling example of obstruction of justice, misconduct in office, misprision, and conspiracy in doing same under common law, requiring McLean to be investigated and prosecuted by Michigan Attorney General in accordance with MCL 14.142, MCL 750.478 and MCL 750.505. See also PD 04.110A, PD 02.03.107 (B), PD 03.02.130, PD 03.03.130 and MDCC Work Rules Nos 1, 3, 5, 9, 13, 22, 27, 33 & 47. Moreover, McLean's aiding and abetting in the unlawful interference with U.S.P.S mail in violation of 18 USC §§ 1702 & 1703, rises to the level of a conspiracy to violate grievant's civil rights requiring investigation and prosecution by the U.S. Attorney's Office in accordance with 18 USC §§ 241 & 242, which requires said remedy and remedy demanded at Step I must be granted.

STEP III - Reason for Appeal As shown in Steps I & II the unwarranted destruction of grievant's mail has not been denied, therefore must be taken as true. Also true is the ongoing staff corruption at URF, a prison notorious for staff corruption, and the collusion of the new Warden, Connie Herbert, in the gross violation and cover-up of grievant's civil rights as set forth at Step I. Wherefore, grievant demands an investigation and prosecution of all concerned for, at minimum, failure to know and follow rules, policy and procedure, failure to perform their duties, obstruction of justice, willful neglect of duty, misprision and misconduct in office in violation of MCL 14.142, MCL 750.478 and MCL 750.505. Thus, this matter should be turned over to the U.S.P.S. Postal Inspector's Office and U.S. Attorney General's Office for investigation and prosecution for the violation of grievant's civil rights, interference with U.S. mail, and conspiracy, 18 USC §§ 1702, 1703, 241 & 242.

On 2/06/18, grievant received Workers World, Vol. 60, No. 5, Feb. 1, 2018, with the mailing label torn ~~off~~, damaging page 122 of the paper, in violation of OP 05.03.118A (C) (6)(a), as well as MCL 200.43, 18 USC §§ 1702 & 1703 and state and federal Constitutions, U.S. Const. Art. I, and Mich. Const. 1963, art. 1, § 5. Said failure to comply with rules, policy and procedure is itself a violation of rules, policy, procedure and state law. PD 01.04.110A; PD 02.03.107(C); PD 03.03.130; MDOC Work Rules Mos. 1, 3, 5, 9, 13, 22, 27, 33 & 47; MCL 19.142; MCL 750.478; MCL 750.505. This continued violation of state and federal law and constitutions rises to the level of a direct violation of and conspiracy to violate grievant's and sender's civil rights. 18 USC §§ 241 & 242. Wherefore, grievant demands mail room employees cease removing labels from periodicals sent by publishers ~~of Michigan~~ and comply with ~~PD~~ OP 05.03.118A (C) (6)(a), and stop destroying and interfering with his and sender's U.S.P.S. mail, and that they be subject to employee discipline per PD 02.03.100, with this matter turned over to U.S. Postal Inspectors for investigation and prosecution.
